

SITE PRESENTATION AND SEARCH WAY


1. Choose the language in which you want to view the page: Portuguese or English. Click on top right corner to change the language (A). At this top right corner, you can view the page in full screen (B).



2. To start your search, choose an area from the menu at the top left corner (C).



3. When selecting an area, you can go down to three more levels within it (its internal subdivision):



4. On the left on the rig side of the screen you find the view menus: kind of exhibition, kind of search and external search.

On the left On the right side, the entry is shown in English and f the screen Portuguese.




KIND OF EXHIBITION: NORMAL AND EXTENDED

- 5. The kinds of exhibition represent two different moments in the history of dictionaries:
- I. **Normal exhibition -** which shows the entry in the same way as paper dictionaries.



- II. **Extended exhibition:** the new dictionaries, in electronic way, offer this search way where each item of the entry description appears in different lines. Note, in this example, that not all the fields are fulfilled. This is because the information we obtained from the corpus was not enough to fulfill all the fields available.

b) In Portuguese




INTERNAL SEARCHES: TOTAL AND MODULAR

The kinds of searches were divided in two:

- I. **Total**: it shows all the available fields (see the example above).
- II. **Modular**: in this search, you choose the fields you want to see. See the following example. We selected, the extended kind of exhibition and checked out (when you click the mouse on the green fields on the left side, they turn gray) the fields gender, morphosyntactic variants,

corpus, examples, encyclopedic information and cross-reference.



Click the screen on the left-hand side and create your structure according to your needs!


RESOURCES

a) External Searches

In addition to the types of internal searches available in the vocabulary, you can also do external searches to Google website. By clicking on Google name, you will be directed to an automatic search for the term defined on the platform.


b) Pronunciation

VoBLing provides the term pronunciation in Portuguese and North American English. Just click on the sound icon and listen to it.




c) Pop-up with definitions

The **Close** button is located at the bottom right corner of the screen, and you can also click **Esc**, if you prefer.



d) See also

Click on **See Also** (D) and you will have access to the cross-references (hyperlink) to the entry defined in the window.



e) Image

You will find the Image icon (

) at the bottom corner of the Definition field.

Click on this icon and you can see an image of the term conceptual organization in the field of Linguistics.



f) Video

Following the **Image** icon, you can find the **Video** icon at the bottom of the definition screen. Click on this icon () and a window will open. Then, a 5-15-minute video about the word will start.
